DO'S AND DON'T'S - FOR STUDENTS :

DO'S

- Acquaint yourself with Google Meet before June 8th.
- Make a small study corner with comfortable chair and a table in a well-lit room.
- Study corner must be secluded from any kind of noise/distraction.
- Check for fans and coolers that do not make any noise.
- For online sessions, students are expected to be dressed neatly in their school uniform and the hair well combed.
- Should wear comfortable shoes in case of a Zumba class.
- All students MUST MUTE their microphones as and when directed by their teachers.
- Student must Pin the teachers Video or Presentation screen.
- Join the session at least 5-10 minutes before the session time.
- Turn off your Audio and Video when you join the class.
- Keep basic material like text books, note books, other stationary material close to you and a bottle of drinking water before the session begins.
- List your questions. The teacher will clear your doubts at the end of her session.
- Submit your assignments on time.
- Have a nutritious lunch and rest your eyes a bit during the lunch break (12:25pm to 1:10 pm)
- LOG OUT AFTER EACH SESSION

DON'T'S

- No student should tamper with the Google Meet settings once the session is in progress.
- Students should never disturb the class teacher while she is teaching.
- Except the student, NO other family member should be visible or participating in the Google Meet session.
- Casual chats (Hi, Hellos, etc.) are NOT permitted in the chat box.
- Should NOT share your screen while the class is in progress.
- Do NOT yawn, show disinterest in the class.
